A St. Patrick's Day Recipe For YOU!

SHAMROCK PUDDING

3 T cornstarch
1/3 cup sugar
1/4 tsp. salt
1/4 tsp. vanilla
Green food coloring to desired color.

2 1/4 cups milk

Mix cornstarch, sugar, and salt together. Add 1/4 cup cold milk to dry ingredients. Stir until smooth and leave aside. Scald two cups milk over double boiler. Add cold mixture to hot milk and cook 15 minutes until mixture thickens, stirring often. Cool slightly and add vanilla. Chill. Serve in individuals dessert bowls and top with whipped cream if desired.


